HUNTING RETRIEVER PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT & LIABILITY WAIVER

This Hunting Retriever Participation Agreement and Liability Waiver (the "Agreement") is entered into by and between **Holy Hunt**, including its partners, guides, officers, owners, and affiliates (collectively, "Holy Hunt"), and the undersigned participant (the "Participant").

In consideration of being permitted to bring a personal hunting retriever or canine companion (the "Retriever") onto properties managed, leased, owned, or utilized by Holy Hunt for hunting operations, the Participant hereby agrees to the following terms and conditions:

1. RETRIEVER PARTICIPATION FEE

The Participant agrees to pay an additional non-refundable fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) to bring their personal Retriever on the designated hunt. This fee is due and payable prior to the commencement of any hunting activities.

2. RELEASE OF LIABILITY FOR CANINE INJURY

The Participant acknowledges that hunting environments are inherently dangerous and involve rugged terrain, thick brush, water hazards, unpredictable wildlife, and various physical obstacles.

Holy Hunt and its partners are not responsible or liable for any injuries, illness, medical conditions, or incidents regarding the Retriever. The Participant explicitly assumes all risks associated with the Retriever's participation, including but not limited to: cuts, lacerations, puncture wounds, broken bones, or infections caused by sticks, branches, debris, barbed wire fences, rough terrain, freezing water, thermal stress, or encounters with wildlife. The Participant agrees that any and all veterinary care and associated costs resulting from the hunt are the sole financial responsibility of the Participant.

3. HUNT-ALTERING EVENTS & PERFORMANCE WAIVER

The Participant acknowledges that a Retriever's behavior can directly impact the quality, outcome, and success of a hunt for all participants.

Holy Hunt is not responsible for, nor shall be held liable for, any hunt-altering event or disrupted hunting opportunity caused by the actions or behavior of the Retriever. This includes, but is not limited to: excessive barking, whining, breaking from the blind/stand, flaring birds, failing to retrieve downed game, or any other


behavior that alerts game or impairs the hunting experience. In the event that the Retriever alters or spoils a hunt, Holy Hunt will not offer refunds, credits, discounts, or rescheduling opportunities to the Participant or any member of the hunting party.

4. CONTROL AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

The Participant agrees to maintain strict control over the Retriever at all times. If, at the sole discretion of the Holy Hunt guide or representative, the Retriever is deemed unsafe, uncontrollable, or overly disruptive to other hunters or staff, the Guide reserves the right to require the Participant to kennel or remove the Retriever from the active hunting area immediately.
